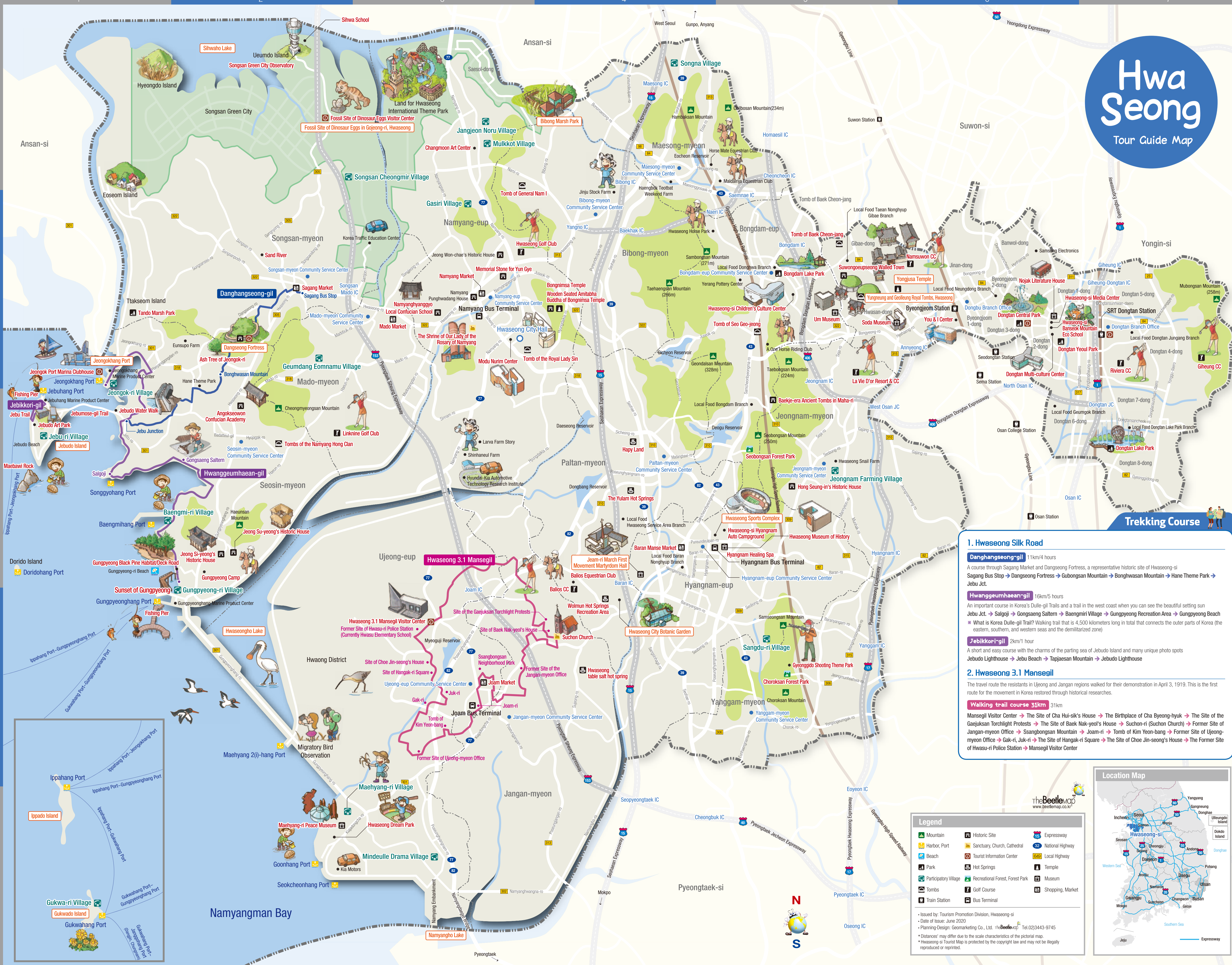

## 1. Hwaseong Silk Road

**Danghangseong-gil** 11km/4 hours

A course through Sagang Market and Dangseong Fortress, a representative historic site of Hwaseong-si

Sagang Bus Stop → Dangseong Fortress → Gubongsan Mountain → Bonghwasan Mountain → Hane Theme Park → Jebu Jct.

**Hwanggeumhaean-gil** 16km/5 hours

An important course in Korea's Dulle-gil Trails and a trail in the west coast when you can see the beautiful setting sun

※ What is Korea Dulle-gil Trail? Walking trail that is 4,500 kilometers long in total that connects the outer parts of Korea (the eastern, southern, and western seas and the demilitarized zone)

**Jebikkori-gil** 2km/1 hour

A short and easy course with the charms of the parting sea of Jebudo Island and many unique photo spots

## 2. Hwaseong 3.1 Mansegil

The travel route the resistants in Ujeong and Jangnam regions walked for their demonstration in April 3, 1919. This is the first route for the movement in Korea restored through historical researches.

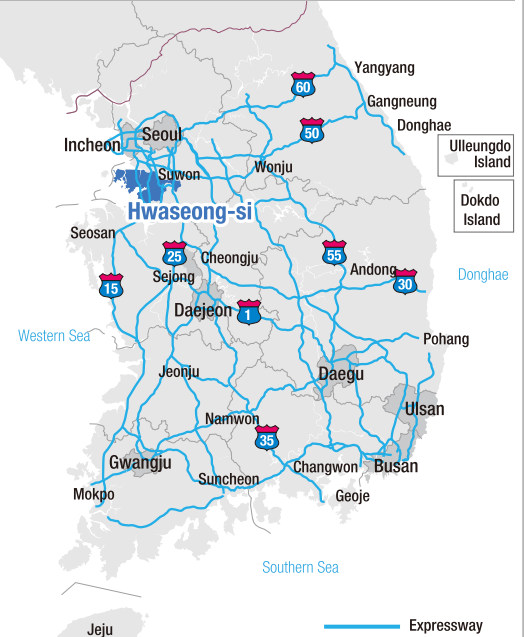

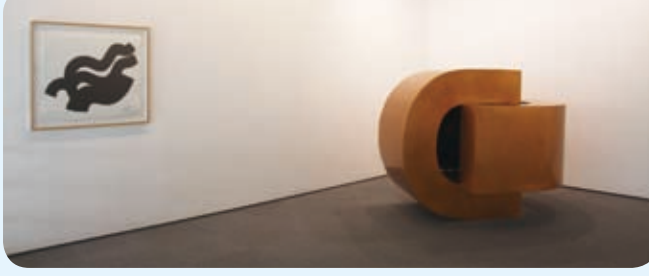
## Nojak Literature House

# Nature Ecology

## Fossil Site of Dinosaur Eggs in Gojeong-ri, Hwaseong

Cultural Tourism Guide



This is presumed to be a group spawning ground of Cretaceous dinosaurs of the Mesozoic era about 100 million years ago. It is one of the three dinosaur egg fossil sites in the world, and was designated as Natural Monument No. 414. Here, you can see the fossil of the 'Koreacratops hwaseongensis,' the first horned dinosaur in Korea, discovered in 2008 at the breakwater of Jeongokhang Port.

## Sihwaho Lake



Sihwaho Lake, once a byword for environmental pollution, has been reborn as a lake of life through continuous efforts of conservationists. The number of species of birds that are natural treasures amounted to seven in 2005, but have now increased to 24. The lake is becoming an important habitat for different species of birds and mud flat organisms.

## Hwaseongho Lake



Located on Gungpyeonghang Port, to Seosin-myeon, Maehyang-ri, and Ujeong-eup section (9.8km), the size of this freshwater lake is 17.3kr, more than twice the size of Yeouido. You can observe various birds at Hwaseongho Lake, a stopover for tens of thousands of migratory birds. At all tide, you can also see Eastern curlew, an endangered species of birds designated by the Ministry of Environment.

An observatory at 100 meters above sea-level on Ueumdo Island, where you can view the Songsan Green City Complex, habitats for migratory birds, the Fossil Site of Dinosaur Eggs, and the area around Sihwaho Lake.

## Bibong Marsh Park



An artificial marsh created at the intersection of three rivers of Hwaseong-si and Ansan-si, to improve the water quality of Sihwaho Lake and restore the natural ecology. The thick reed field and marsh are a habitat for many migratory birds. There are facilities such as observation paths, an observatory, a rest area, etc.

As it gave military superiority through trade with the Tang, conflicts among the Three Kingdoms over this strategic location never ceased. A restoration project is in progress.
